- Veterinary treatment for injuries and diseases.
- Humane euthanasia of terminally ill animals.
- Confiscation of animals where intentional cruelty occurs.

Dogtown SA is a pro-life, animal rehabilitation center, specializing in so-called "problem" dogs. We prefer to call them misunderstood dogs. We provide them with the best care and rehabilitation programs, from behavior modification to extensive medical treatments. This includes a full medical examinations, microchips, vaccinations and sterilizations. The dogs in our care are assessed and then an individual training program is put into place by our 4 internal behaviorists. We aim to offer lifelong commitment to the dogs that come into our care and a lifetime of support to their new families.

Our focus is to help dogs that need our specific expertise and we take in dogs from other rescue centers who are struggling to home them because of a behavior or medical problems. We also have a retirement village for older dogs as a lot of the time older dogs with medical issues are dumped at centers around the country with less chance of finding lovable homes. Our focus being on misunderstood dogs, does not allow us to take in easily home able dogs.

SanWild provides a *free emergency wildlife rescue service* whenever and wherever a wild animal is in need. Although we are based in Limpopo, we rescue animals and work closely with veterinarians across all the provinces of South Africa. With the help of international charities and authorities, we also participate in international afar afield as France, Belgium and the United Kingdom.

Our Criteria is quite simple, if an animal is in need, we will respond wherever possible irrespective of the specie's conservation status of importance. Each case is evaluated on an individual basis. Wherever possible we will treat and release an animal in the area that it came from, but in cases where there is an ongoing danger to the animal, it will be relocated to the safety of the SanWild Wildlife Sanctuary or any other suitable wildlife sanctuary where it can be accommodated.
